- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 4 weeks after the application deadline.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 6 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
 - A SALZBUR01: A Transcript of Records will be provided through the intranet platform, PLUSonline. Each student can print out the transcript of records personally.
- 4. Termination of the Agreement. Notice about a unilateral termination of the agreement should be given at least one academic year ahead. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
