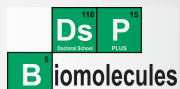

Mario Gimona

He received his PhD in Genetics and Cell Biology in Salzburg and spent his postdoctoral period at the Cold Spring Harbor Laboratory in New York. At PMU he helped design and build a GMP-grade clean room lab, where he conducts research focused on the development of novel stem cell-based therapeutics

Wolfgang Sommergruber

He received his PhD at the Institute of Biochemistry in Vienna. Since 1986, he started to work at Boehringer Ingelheim, and since 2002, he is the Group Leader of the Department of Exploratory Research. He conducts research focused on tumor metabolism and identification of novel drug intervention sites in oncology.

Harald Schnidar

He obtained his PhD in Genetics in Salzburg. He worked as Project Head and Business Associate at the APEIRON Biologics, Vienna, focusing on the clinical phase Ib development of liposomal rhSOD in radiodermatitis. In 2014, he founded SCARLETRED Holding in Vienna, centred on the development and marketing of the medical device Scarletred®Vision® for dermatology.

Michael Hauser

He obtained his PhD in Natural Sciences in Salzburg. He worked for 4 years at Roche Diagnostics in Germany as Plant Manager and Group Leader, where he was responsible for GMP certified industrial DS production. Since 2017, he is Senior Research Scientist in the Research Group of Fatima Ferreira.
