

## Double Degree EUS – Guide for outgoing students to OLOMOUC

Congratulations on deciding to do a Double Degree in Olomouc!  
You will have a great time there and will be able to graduate in two programmes at once:

**MA in European Union Studies at Salzburg University**

**Mgr. in European Studies with focus on European Law at Olomouc University**

To make the best of your studies, this document will guide you through the organizational matters. ### General framework of the DD:

1. After you were selected for a study place in the DD Olomouc, you will start applying for an **Erasmus-scholarship** at the [International office](#).

Make sure to do that early enough as the application deadlines are set quite early in the semester.

You received *info via email*, including a *table of courses* you need to do in Olomouc and their recognitions, this will be the basis for filling your learning agreement.

2. Whilst managing the Erasmus-procedure during the wintersemester in Salzburg you have to pass all the classes of the **third semester in EUS** (see the EUS [Study Guide](#))
3. For the summer semester you will be going to **Olomouc**.

There you have to start the **regular enrolment process** at Olomouc University!

You will initially have the status of an Erasmus-student for one semester – the semester you will be present at Palacky University and following your courses. But after that you have to be enrolled as a regular student for an additional year to be able to obtain the degree!  
(In this additional year you do not have to be present in Olomouc).

**Caution: the enrolment procedure in Olomouc starts in February! So you have to start it in the beginning of your stay.**

In your infomail you have gotten a *smartinfo* guiding you through the regular Olomouc enrollment procedure. Radana will also be happy to help you.

Do not mix up the Erasmus-procedure and the regular enrolment at Olomouc University. They are two separate procedures and you have to follow both to be able to obtain your DD.

- You will then be a regular student in Olomouc for one regular study year, meaning for one winter- and summersemester after your Erasmus stay.

**Caution: you have to graduate until the end of this study year!**

In practice that means you have to write your thesis and do your **Master exam** in **Salzburg** until the end of the summersemester following the one you spent in Olomouc (so one year later). The last possible master exams in EUS take place in June.

Then you have to hand in several documents in Olomouc, mainly a request for recognition and the Salzburg Diploma including a Diploma Supplement and Transcript of Records. Radana will help you. This has to be done in August at the latest to get the **Olomouc degree** as well.

Please stick to that schedule when planning your next semesters and your time frame for thesis and master exam!

**Courses:**

You have received a list of courses you will be following in Olomouc including the possible recognitions in Salzburg. Just stick to that list and Radanas advice. You are always welcome to do additional courses as free electives, if you like.

### Thesis and Master Exam:

You will write your thesis in co-supervision from Salzburg and Olomouc Professors. The topic needs to touch issues related to the Czech Republic.

Make sure your supervisors know your thesis is written in the context of the Double Degree and stay in touch with both your supervisors.

When handing in your thesis in Salzburg you also have to send it to your supervisor in Olomouc, as you need TWO reviews.

Your Olomouc supervisor will also send some questions for your master exam, which will then be asked by the commission.
