FACULTY OF LAW, BUSINESS AND ECONOMICS

A comprehensive structural reform at the Paris Lodron University Salzburg (PLUS) came into force at the beginning of 2022. The PLUS now consists of six faculties. The Faculty of Law was transformed into the Faculty of Law, Business and Economics (RWW).

The RWW Faculty is divided into the following departments: The departments of Economics, Business Management as well as Legal Theory, International and European Law have been created. These three join the existing departments of Labour Law and Business Law, Public Law, Private Law and Criminal Law and Criminal Procedural Law.

The combination of law and economics in a single faculty is what distinguishes the PLUS's profile in this area.

"Law and economics within the same faculty offers even greater opportunities for cooperation than ever before. The idea to merge the two is a result of common research questions and the increase in demand for interdisciplinary approaches in discipline-oriented research," emphasises Dean Prof. Johannes Michael Rainer.

"Teaching will benefit from this transdisciplinary approach and integration of both law and economics," says Rainer.
