German Intensive Language Course

1) Information on the German Course

The course is two weeks long and takes place **before** the start of the semester. The course times are coordinated with the Orientation Week programme. It is possible to participate in the Orientation Week and the German Intensive Language Course at the same time.

Duration: 15 - 28 February 2023

= 10 course days with three teaching units of 45 minutes each; corresponds to 30 UE

Course times:

from Wednesday, 15 February 2023, to Tuesday, 28 February 2023:

from Monday to Friday: 10:15 a.m. - 11:45 a.m. and 12:15 p.m. - 1:00 p.m.

<u>Update on COVID-19</u>: It is planned to hold the course in face-to-face teaching in Salzburg. If there are any changes at short notice, you will be informed in time.

Course criteria:

You will receive **3 ECTS credits** for successful participation. **Attendance** in the course must be **at least 80%.** (Further absences cannot be compensated by additional assignments.)

The final grade is made up of the following parts:

50 % Final test

10 % 2 learning assessments

20 % Portfolio and homework

20 % participation in class

Contribution to costs: € 50.00 per course (excl. bank charges)

The contribution amount for students is based on the regulation of the rectorate about a contribution towards expenses for extracurricular teaching at the University of Salzburg (in Mitteilungsblatt 66, 21.07.2020). Therefore, for 2 semester hours per week (blocked for 2 weeks) you have to pay € 50.00.

Note: If you would like to attend additional courses during the semester that are subject to a fee, these must be paid for separately. Information will be provided during the Orientation Week.

2) Registration Process and Payment

Step 1: Registration by E-mail

Registration is to be done by e-mail to <u>deutsch-intensiv-germanistik@plus.ac.at</u> (Eva V. Gatterbauer, Department of German Languages and Literature, German as a Foreign Language (DaF)).

To register for the course, send the result of the language test (PDF document or screenshot) by e-mail to deutsch-intensiv-germanistik@plus.ac.at.

(The language test does <u>not</u> affect your grade in the course. It only helps us to assess your language level). You will then receive a **reply** as to whether there are still places available in the language course.

Step 2: Payment

Schritt 3: Confirmation of Registration



You will receive a confirmation of your course registration by e-mail. You are now registered for the course.

Further Information:

The course will only take place if **at least 5 students** have registered. The decision whether a course will take place or has to be cancelled will be made on 10 February 2023. The paid course fee will be refunded to you (minus any bank charges) if the course does not take place.

Cancellation Policy:

You can cancel your registration **free** of charge **until 9 February 2023** by sending an e-mail to petra.hoepfner@plus.ac.at (International Relations Office Salzburg) or deutsch-intensiv-germanistik@plus.ac.at. The paid course fee (minus any bank charges) will be transferred back or paid out in cash in Salzburg. In case of cancellation **between 10 and 15 February 2023**, 50 % of the course fee, i.e. € 25,00, will be retained. **After 16 February**, no refund of the course fee is possible.

Registrations will be ranked according to the receipt of the payment confirmation of the course fee. If more people register than can attend, there will be a **waiting list**. People on the waiting list will be informed after 10 February 2023 if they can attend the language course.
