TRANSCRIPT	A transcript in English is required for Admission as per of the application process.
Undergraduate	The number of semesters per School for undergraduate students is indicated below, and includes existing agreements in place. We ask you to nominate no more than 2 students per subject. Nominated students will be required to select at least 60% of their classes in the subject in which they are nominated; where possible students will be permitted to select 40% of their classes in other subjects/Schools.
Postgraduate taught (Study)	Masters students normally take undergraduate classes; access to level 5 classes will be assessed and considered on request and are subject to availability. Places will be included in the number of semesters available below. <b>N.B.:</b> Formal transcripts for Level 5 courses are only available each year in October subsequent to PGT Exam Boards which take place at the very end of the degree cycle rather than at the end of each semester.
Doctorate / research project	It may be possible to host Postgraduate for research placement <b>in addition to the number indicated below. Each application will be considered on its own merit and will depend on the capacity of the chosen mentor to host the PhD student.</b> Students should approach the graduate schools with a proposal in the first instance, and secure an academic mentor at Glasgow prior to nomination. Students will not be accepted without a confirmed host mentor. Host mentors at UofG are not co-supervisors and will not read/mark students work; the mentor's role is to help students integrate into the postgraduate and academic community and access relevant networks and resources that are unique to UoG. Students are thus expected to be self-directed and to continue working primarily with their home supervisor throughout the duration of their exchange to achieve required milestones. <b>Once a mentor is identified, the student must be nominated to the UofG Visiting student team by the home international office/Erasmus Office (as applicable)</b>
Traineeships	We are centralising the process to support trainees. The Global Opportunities team will manage requests in the first instance.
