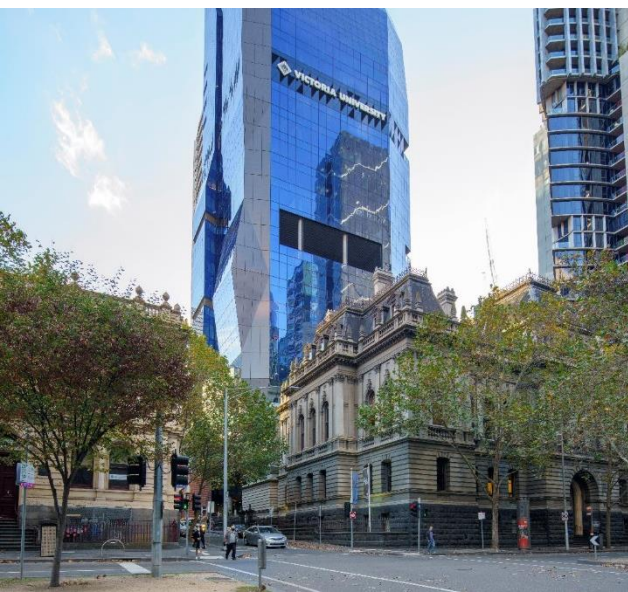

# Study Programmes

- **All PLUS students** can apply

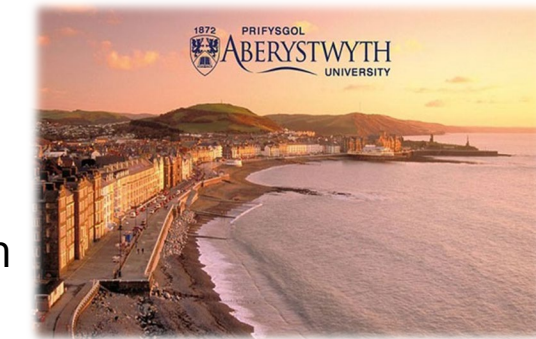
## Erasmus+

- contracts at **departmental levels**

⇒ Department of English and American Studies => English Schools

- **restrictions** on study programmes (goodwill of the partner university)
- **students of English & American Studies** will be prioritised
- PLUS students from other disciplines *can* apply for remaining places => Academic Coordinators & partner university decide on nomination

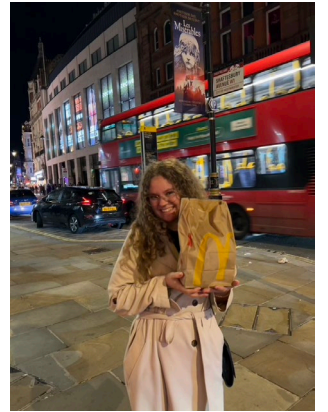

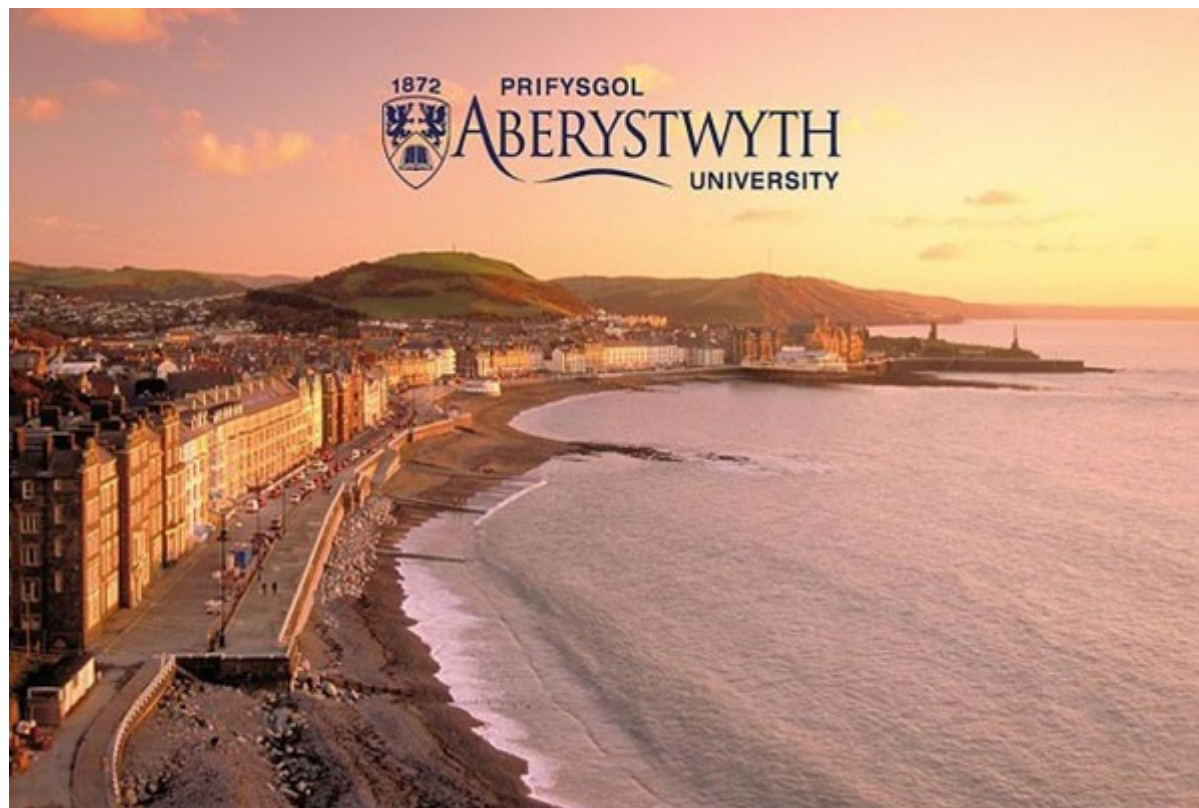

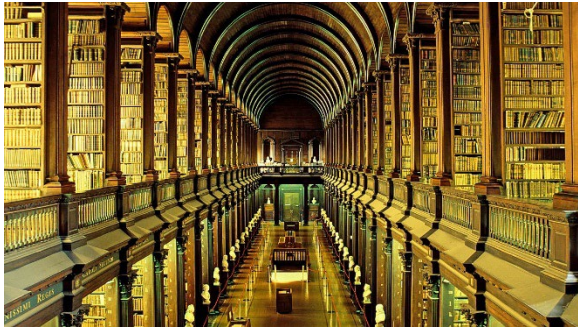

# Application procedure and deadlines

## Internal application deadlines (PLUS)

- [Application](#) to coordinator
  - Deadline: **31 January** of a calendar year for the following academic year  
=> after this deadline, only remaining places will be allocated
- Application at the **International Office** (grants, mobility status)
  - [Study Abroad](#)
  - [Erasmus+](#)

## Deadlines of the partner universities

- **Nomination Deadlines** (from PLUS to partner)
  - Semester 1 & Full Year: **April–May**
  - Semester 2: **September–October**
- **Application Deadlines** (from nominated students to partners)
  - Semester 1 & Full Year: **April–June**
  - Semester 2: **October–November**

# What do I need to apply?

- Completed **two semesters** of university education and be in **good academic standing**
- **Transcript** of Records (in English)
- Letter of **motivation** in English (approx. 250-300 words)
- English **language requirements**



# English language requirements

## UK (Study Abroad)

- **official language certificates**, *minimally* at B2 level or higher (TOEFL, IELTS 6.5 OR 6.0) => must not exceed a certain date of issue
- see **homepages** of the partner universities

## Ireland (Erasmus+)

- students of English & American Studies => usually do NOT have to provide proof of language proficiency (depends on partner university)
- all other PLUS students must provide proof of language proficiency

# Financial Support

## Study Abroad (UK)

- [Study Abroad Grant](#)
- grant duration: min. 1 term, max. 1 academic year
- only grants (not full scholarships) awarded for living & travel expenses
- monthly allowance: **€ 487**
- one-time travel subsidy: **€ 161**
- **NO legal entitlement** to the grant
- financial resources are limited => **zero grant** possible

## Erasmus+ (Ireland)

- [Erasmus+ Grant](#)
- based on the Erasmus+ budget available to PLUS
- currently, at least **4,5 months** (in combination with **zero grant**)
- monthly allowance for Ireland (Region 14): **€ 490**
- one-time travel subsidy: consult International Office
- duration of scholarship: application for 1 semester (extensions are **NO** longer possible) – a **separate application** must be submitted **for each semester**

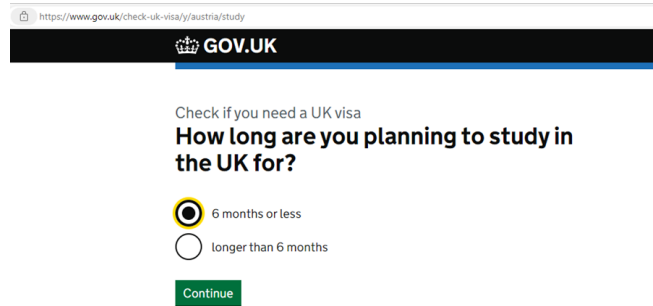

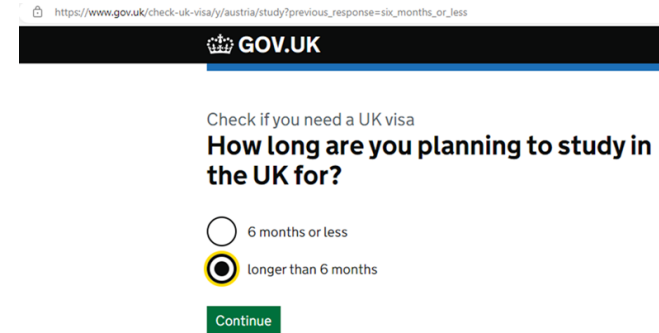

# Accreditation

- Students need to select appropriate options for **full-time academic enrolment: 60 ECTS** (= 120 British credits) **per academic year** or **30 ECTS** (= 60 British credits) **per single semester**. This is both an academic and visa requirement. All students are assigned an Academic Adviser in their primary area of study at the partner university.
- At least **3 ECTS per month** of stay must be recognised at the home university.
- Recognition at the PLUS must be signed by the CuKo chairperson or responsible Global Opportunities Advisor.

- Students will be nominated for a study place at the chosen partner university (host institution) by the responsible Academic Coordinator and informed about the nomination => Places are allocated according to availability and academic performance.
- Wait for the partner university to confirm your nomination.
- Then complete all the forms required by the partner university => Please note the different deadlines of the partner universities.
- Fill in all necessary forms of the International Relations Office of the University of Salzburg according to the respective guidelines.

# Deadlines of the coordinators

(English & American Studies, Herzog) for internal applications (PLUS)

## Semester 1 & Full Academic Year

- **End of January** of the following academic year (e.g. 31 January 2024 for the academic year 2024/2025)
- For applications received **after 31 January**, study places are allocated on an ongoing basis and **according to availability**.

## Semester 2

- **End of June** of the following summer semester (e.g. 30 June 2024 for the summer semester 2025)
- At this deadline, **only remaining places** will be allocated and it is not guaranteed that there will still be places available for your chosen university!
- It is **recommended** that you also **use the deadline for a Full Academic Year** for Semester 2.
