ABOUT “FUDAN UNIVERSITY”

- Fudan University was established in 1905 as Fudan Public School. It was the first institution of higher education to be founded by Chinese individuals.
- The two characters, 复 fu (“return”) and 旦 dan (“dawn”) were quoted from *A Commentary on The Classic of History* 《尚书大传 • 虞夏传》, which means: “Brilliant are the sunshine and moonlight, again the morning radiance returns at dawn.” It is an encouragement to students and scholars to make unremitting efforts in self-betterment.

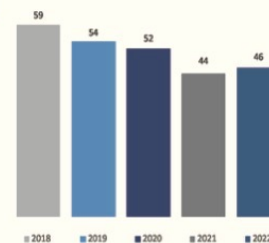

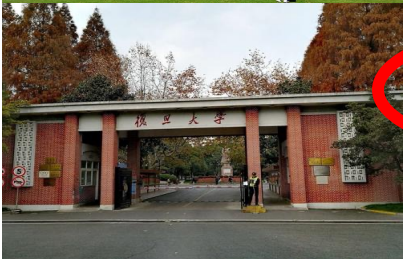
Metropolis Shanghai

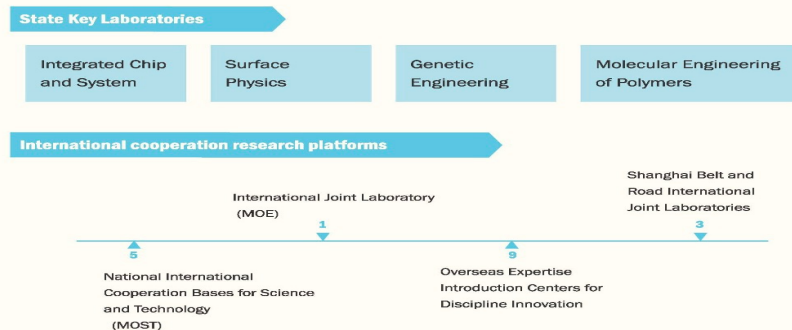


Natural Sciences and New Engineering

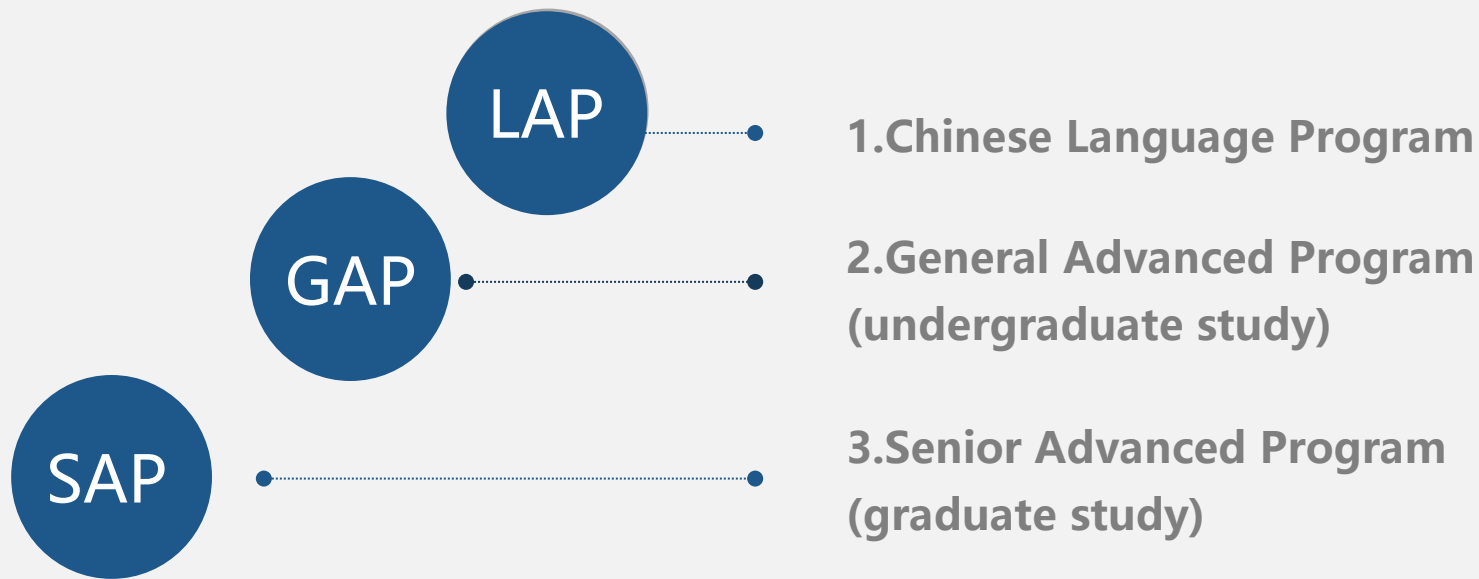

General Advanced Program (GAP)

There are both English-taught and Chinese-taught courses.

Students in this program will take **undergraduate-level courses** at FUDAN. GAP students will be assigned to a school/department and a field of study similar to the major at home university.

Despite the assigned field, students **can select courses from different schools and departments at the same time.**

In general, General Advanced Program students CAN NOT take Chinese Language courses at ICES. Limited Chinese Language courses at ICES and non-credit Chinese language training classes might be available in this program, but there is NO guarantee that they will be available every semester.

Undergraduate-level courses in basic medical sciences, clinical medicine, and nursing are not available.

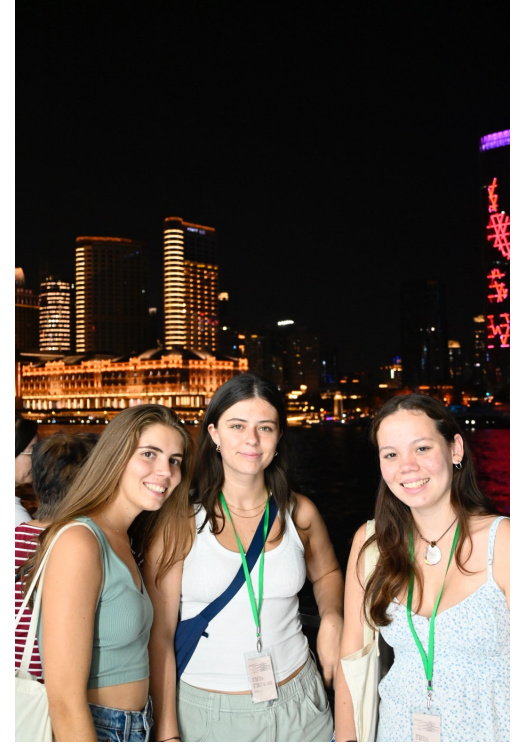
