

# **FOR APAC International Asia Know-How Summer School 2025 Terms and Conditions**

## **Agreement with the Paris Lodron University of Salzburg (PLUS)**

These Terms and Conditions set the basis of your relationship with PLUS when you apply for the FOR APAC Asia Know-How Summer School Program.

Your contract with PLUS is made up of these Terms and Conditions, your application, and the full payment of the tuition fees.

## **Tuition fees**

The fee for attendance of the Summer School amounts to 3.888 EUR for the long version of the Summer School program and 2.500 EUR for the short version of the Summer School program. This includes fees for accommodation (including breakfast), bus/train transfers in China, lecture fees, excursions, entrance fees and for other activities included in the official program.

Please refer to your bank regarding bank transfer fees and make sure that the payment will be received by PLUS without deductions.

## **Cancellation Period**

If you wish to cancel your participation in the Summer School, please send us a short e-mail with a brief explanation of the reason.

For any drop out between the 1<sup>st</sup> and the 30<sup>th</sup> of June 2025, we will claim 50% of the program costs.

After the 30<sup>th</sup> of June 2025, we are claiming a 100% cancelation fee.

## **Delivery of the Program**

Under exceptional circumstances, we may consider it appropriate to cancel or significantly change the course of the Program. This could be for reasons including but not limited to the following:

- If there are not enough applicants registered for the Summer School.
- If an event outside of our reasonable control prevents us from running the Summer School or the Course.
- Force majeure.

In such cases, the tuition fee will be returned.

In case that the service or event is only partially carried out, the fee will only be refunded on a pro rata basis.

## **Your Responsibilities**

By accepting the conditions, you agree to:

- Be punctual in attending lectures, excursions, and visits and for the transfers. We will record student attendance on a daily basis in class registers.
- You are required to attend ALL CLASSES in order to qualify for an attendance certificate and 5 ECTS credits (apart from sick leave) for the long version of the program or 3 ECTS credits for the short version of the program (apart from sick leave). The following events are also mandatory: Introduction, Final Discussion, Exams.
- After the completion of the Summer School, a final essay (800 – 1000 words for the long version, and 500 – 800 words for the short version) is required by the 30<sup>th</sup> of September 2025.
- If you are absent for health reasons you must inform us by e-mail, WeChat/WhatsApp or in person and such non - attendance will be excused.

## **Intellectual Property**

All materials provided by the Summer School of the PLUS and any intellectual property rights in them shall remain the property of the PLUS or the professors holding the lectures. You are not allowed to film any of the lectures without the permission of the respective lecturer.

It is agreed that domestic Austrian law shall apply to all disputes arising from the contractual relationship in question, as well as to any tort claims. The courts of the city of Salzburg are agreed as the exclusive place of jurisdiction for all disputes arising from the present contractual relationship, as well as for any tort claims. The subject-matter jurisdiction shall be governed by the rules of domestic Austrian jurisdiction.

**PLUS or FOR APAC will not be held responsible for failure to execute obligations specified herein directly or indirectly occasioned by or through or in consequence of war, change of statutes of the Austrian Government, strikes, riots and acts of God or conditions beyond the control of PLUS or FOR APAC.**
