Both our nomination and application processes should be done through our institutional email mobilidade@pucrs.br. In order to nominate your students, please send us their full name, email address and area of studies.

ACCOMMODATION

The university does not provide accommodation on or off campus. Each student is responsible for arranging their own housing. However, if they have trouble finding a suitable place to stay, they should contact our Office for International Cooperation, as the Academic Mobility team has a list of options to help with accommodation.

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT

Incoming exchange students do not have to submit proof of proficiency in the Portuguese language. However, we highly recommend that they have some knowledge of Portuguese, especially if they enroll in courses that are taught in Portuguese.

GRADING AND CREDIT SYSTEM

The final grade in each course is expressed from zero to ten, calculated up to the first decimal place. Students who obtain a minimum grade 7.0 do not need to take the remedial tests, known as G2. Students who achieve a final grade ≥5.0 (five) and keep a mandatory attendance record of at least 75% in each course will earn a passing grade.

TRANSCRIPT OF RECORDS

At the end of the study period, PUCRS will send an Academic Transcript to the student's home university detailing the completed courses and earned credits, as well as the grades according to the University's grading system. This document will be sent from 2 to 4 weeks after the end of the semester.
