Transfer to TUM

Students must always **first enroll** at the University of Salzburg, even if they begin their studies at TUM in the first semester. The program can **only be started in the winter semester**.

To be able to enroll at TUM, students must be nominated by the University of Salzburg. This is a simple administrative step: students must inform the departmental secretary's office of their wish to be nominated, either by email or in person to either adelheid.ganzera@plus.ac.at or gudrun.riegler@plus.ac.at.

As soon as students plan to begin their studies at TUM, usually in the 1st or 3rd semester, they must also enroll at TUM. **Enrollment at TUM takes place exclusively online via the TUMonline portal.**

For the winter semester, the portal is usually open in the first or second week of September. The exact opening dates of the portal can be requested from the departmental secretary's office from the end of June onward, from Ms. Ganzera or Ms. Riegler.

If you are already in a higher semester and would like to transfer to TUM for the summer semester, please inform the departmental secretary's office in good time, Ms. Ganzera or Ms. Riegler. In this case, there are no regular portal opening dates; the portal is only activated by TUM upon request from the University of Salzburg.

Enrollment via TUMonline

As a first step, create an account and select JD Master *Science and Technology of Materials* as the degree program.

The following documents must be uploaded in the portal as part of the application:

- Confirmation of study periods
- Identity card or passport
- Transcript of courses and grades
- Curriculum vitae
- Confirmation of German statutory health insurance

Please note that this information only provides a general overview and that the required documents may vary in individual cases. TUM decides which documents are required.

Proof of language proficiency is not required, as language skills were assessed during the interview as part of the application process.

After the documents have been checked, you will receive admission by email to your TUM account. **You must then accept the study place online.**

The application for enrollment must be signed and uploaded to the portal.

After successful enrollment in the Master's program, you can register for courses.
