

Information about the Subject exam *Fundamentals of EU Studies*

This subject exam *Fundamentals of EU Studies* requires basic knowledge in the disciplines Political Sciences, Law and Economics, needed for the study programme EUS. It may also contain some questions covering the history of European Integration. The course *Fundamentals of EU Studies* will prepare you for the exam. The exam covers all the material provided in the course – including the presentations in class and the compulsory material provided in advance and on Blackboard.

You need to register for the subject exam separately in Plusonline (it is not enough to be registered for the Fundamentals course alone)!

The exam takes 90 minutes max. and is in written form in presence (no option to do it online). There are no grades, you just need to pass this exam to be allowed in the advanced courses of the second semester (please check the study guide for further info).

You need to answer half of the questions correctly to pass. The exam is composed of single-choice questions and some open short questions.

There will be three exam dates in the Winter Semester. Please check PlusOnline for the list of exam dates and registration. It is recommended to sit the exam on the first available date so that you do not have too many exams at the end of the semester and, even more importantly, to be able to repeat it the same semester in case you do not pass. Students who wait until the third exam date and do not pass will have no further opportunity to retake the exam until the following academic year.
